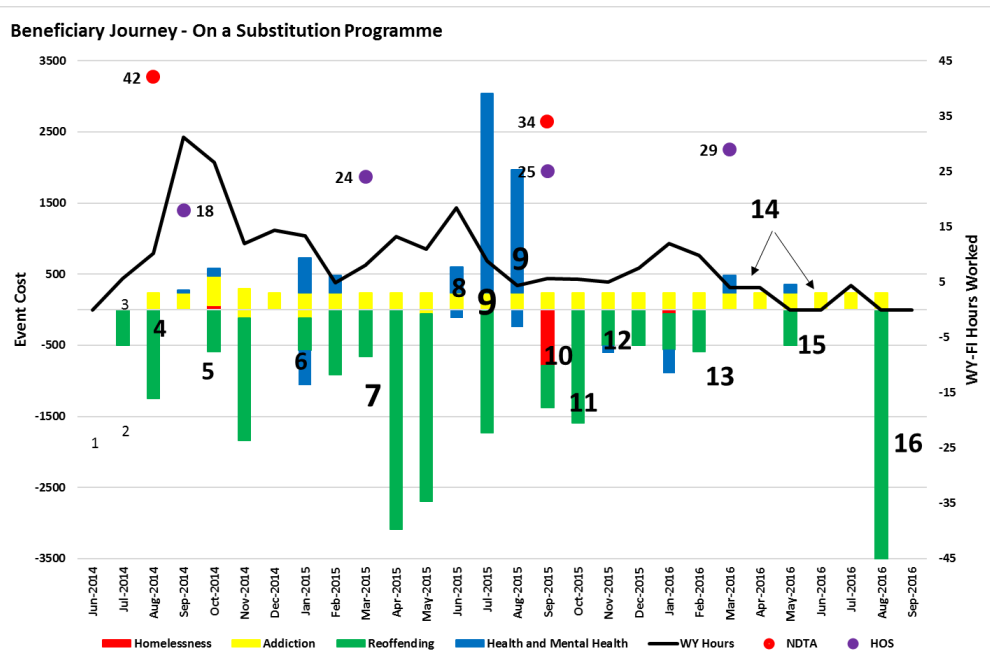
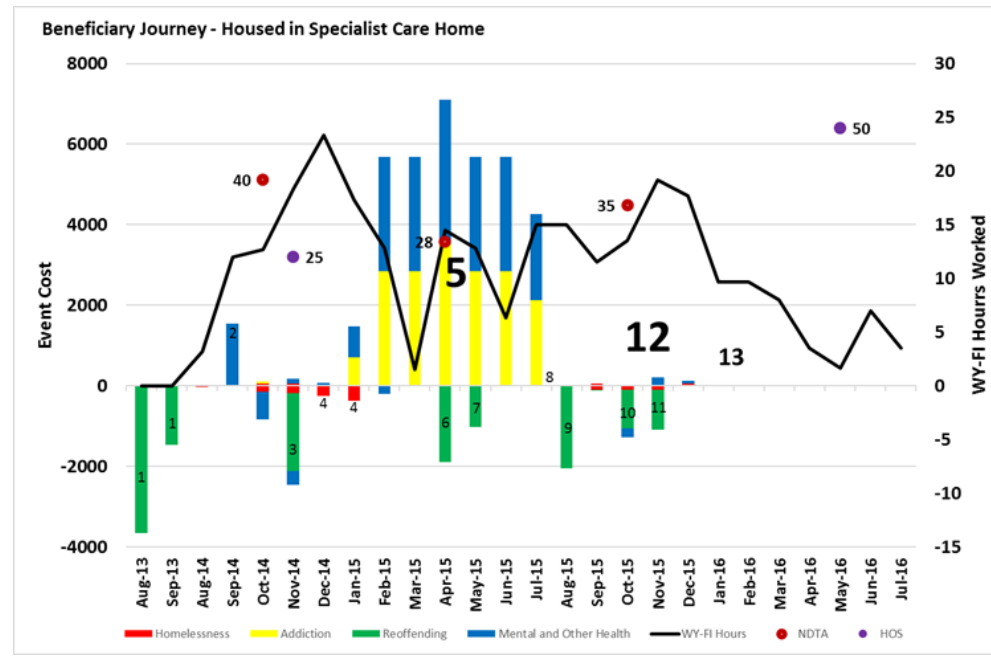


Example WY-FI beneficiary journeys through addiction services

- Beneficiary moved into new flat. One arrest for Breach of Order
- Appearance at Magistrates Court adjourned until Oct 2014
- Beneficiary prescribed Methadone – substitution treatment
- Various visits to doctors and dentists
- Missed Substance Misuse Service appointment, beneficiary missed a court date and was given an ASBO in their absence. Another court case was adjourned for a month. Arrested for assault.
- Beneficiary missed two Dual Diagnosis appointments; court case adjourned
- 8-week sentence in HMP New Hall for Breach of Tag
- Mental Health Assessment
- Two arrests and one court appearance along with 12 days in mental health treatment
- Eviction and arrest for criminal damage
- Plea appearance for Criminal Damage and further arrest
- A&E visit and another arrest
- Arrested for non-appearance at Salford Magistrates
- Intensive Home Treatments Appointments
- Appearance at Salford Magistrates
- In HMP New Hall



Key

- 13 week prison sentence Jun to Sept 2013
- Hospital visit, heart problems
- Arrested for Drunk & Disorderly and night in cells
- Nights in Bradford night shelter
- Housed at Oak Mount – a residential care home for men affected by chronic alcohol use
- Arrested for Assault and court appearance
- Another arrest for Assault
- Evicted from Oak Mount due to unacceptable behaviour
- Two court appearances
- Arrested
- Attendance at Magistrates Court
- Beneficiary living on streets and at Hope Housing – a homeless charity
- Beneficiary moves into new bedsit
