Brendan has a 35-year history of re-offending. When WY-FI first met Brendan, he'd just been released from prison and was living in supported housing. Brendan was struggling to adjust and was using drugs and alcohol to cope.

WY-FI began by supporting Brendan to complete his Probation and break his cycle of re-offending. WY-FI also worked with Brendan to help him address his use of drugs and alcohol.



When Brendan was ready to move into his own flat, WY-FI supported him with practical tasks like filling in housing forms, working out a budget and switching energy providers. They've also helped Brendan find more meaningful ways to spend his time - and now he keeps pigeons.

"Without WY-FI's help, I've no doubt I would be back in prison today. We need places like WY-FI. When you're in a challenging part of your life - they help you to move on."
